SOLAS Approved Rescue Line 30 m

The SOLAS approved Rescue line 30 meters (5200405) is placed across the inner dimensions of the SOLAS Approved Lifebuoy 2,5 kg and fastened with a loop around one side of the Lifebuoy. The SOLAS approved Rescue line 30 meters is crucial for saving people on a greater distance and getting them back to safety while enabling the rescuer to keep a safe distance from the distressed. The SOLAS (Safety of life at sea) Convention in its successive forms is generally regarded as the most important of all international treaties concerning the safety of merchant ships.

Materials

The SOLAS Approved Rescue Line 30 m is made of a rugged twinned orange polyester line contained inside a white polypropylene container. A pictogram is clearly visible on the container with usage instructions.

Lifespan and Maintenance

The lifespan of the Rescue Line depends on where it is placed and how exposed it is to the elements. To increase lifespan, we recommend reviewing the lifebuoy and throwing line every year, if necessary, the Rescue Line can be washed off with water and mild detergent. When the Rescue Line is consumed, it shall be sorted as combustible waste for energy extraction.

The SOLAS Approved Lifebuoy 2,5 kg (520J201) is a premium lifebuoy with a floating capacity for 2 people. Its soft foame core and vinyl clothing, with easy to grip vinyl lines makes it ideal for saving lives in the water. The SOLAS (Safety of life at sea) Convention in its successive forms is generally regarded as the most important of all international treaties concerning the safety of merchant ships.

Since the lifebuoy's weight is 2500g it is possible to throw it far, even in headwind.

The Lifbuoy Post (5610053) is made of aluminium and includes mounting for the SOLAS Approved Lifebuoy and is the preferred mounting solution close to the water, showcasing the SOLAS Approved Lifebuoy, for easy access 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
